Their social kitchen program includes hot food delivery to elderly congregation members who live alone and are unable to cook for themselves. With limited resources, Bishop Zan-Fabian reached out to the *Presbyterian Church in Canada (PCC)* for financial support to continue this ministry of care. The *PCC* provided a grant from *Presbyterians Sharing*, fulfilling the law of Christ to bear one another's burdens.
